4. Update on the 2013 Legislative Session – Victoria Lincoln
 - a. At 5 PM all bills that are policy related have to be voted out of the house of origin or they'll be dead.
 - b. Scheduled to adjourn Sunday April 28th
 - c. Focused on the budget now
 - i. Senate didn't take into account any new revenue and cut more
 - ii. House budget adopted a series of revenue resources and cut less
 - iii. Governor's budget didn't take any of our shared revenues
 - iv. Have 1.2 billion dollar gap
 - v. Want to retain liquor money for the cities and counties
 - d. Only significant telecomm tax bill (House and Gov budget too this into account, senate did not)
 - i. If cities/counties don't resolve who pays taxes for wireless phones, could result in \$250 million refund from city/county pockets.
 - ii. If they approve it, cities and counties want it to avoid having to pay back money in the future, and would resolve all sales tax cost for phone coverage
 - iii. It was voted off the floor, 74 yes votes, it will be a serious contender for bills that will pass this session and will bring in new revenue
 - e. Governor says we're headed for special session, can't be wrapped up in 10 days
 - i. Can last 30 days or less
